The MEAL Officer will support the implementation and strengthening of Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability, and Learning (MEAL) systems across programme activities, ensuring data quality, programme monitoring, and evidence-based decision-making.

- Manage data collection, validation, cleaning, consolidation, and timely MIS data entry.
 - Coordinate and support data collection by field staff and partner organizations.
 - Conduct routine data verification and quality assurance checks.
 - Document MEL activities and track indicator results.
 - Monitor programme and training activities through field visits and review meetings.
 - Provide analysed data for programme planning and strategic decision-making.
 - Collaborate with MEL Manager in developing monitoring frameworks and tools
 - Ensure effective internal communication on MEAL progress and findings.
 - Implement and periodically revise MEL plans, tools, and evaluation processes.
